



The Highly Popular Horoscope Method of 12 Cards' spread





Purpose of the Cards appearing in order

The Ist Card: It indicates all general matters of personal nature, and your chief concems. The IInd Card: It indicates your money-matters, family-members and the things you value most. The IIIrd Card: It indicates general day-to-day activities, and correspondence/ communications. The IVth Card: It indicates your house or home, property, comfort, peace of mind, satisfaction, etc. The Vth Card: It indicates your lover, creativity, entertainment, pleasure, speculation, risks, etc. The Vth Card: It indicates health/ disease, relatives, general occupation, routine work, etc. The VIth Card: It indicates your spouse, business-partner, associates, relationships, etc. The VIIth Card: It indicates joint ventures, money from bank or partner, physical intimacy, etc. The IXth Card: It indicates higher education, challenges, foreign trade, general fortune, etc. The Xth Card: It indicates goals, ambitions, reputation, credibility, honor, business/ profession, etc. The XIth Card: It indicates hobbies, expectations, hopes, own eamings, assistance from friends, etc.

The Highly Popular Horoscope Method of 12 Cards' spread

Card 1 - 75('Valet' of Wands) :

The Ist Card: It indicates all general matters of personal nature, and your chief concerns.

Meaning and Definition of the Card :

This Card corresponds to the 'Valet' of Wands. It is shown as a well-dressed beautiful young boy (or girl) standing in a country setting by holding a wand - which is a bit taller than him - in both of his hands in front of him, and is looking at its top end. His attitude is casual and posture is relaxed. It indicates a person of sensitive nature, but he/ she is faithful - although somewhat lacking in maturity and experience. This card signifies that you can look forward to receive some pleasant news or a message from a young relative or a friend; or it may have some connection with your profession/ business. If this card appears in upright posture, then you will feel relaxed and remain free from worry. However, if this card appears in upside down posture, then the news might be from- or about- your rival or competitor, and as such it can be a source of worry to you. Either way, this card normally does not indicate a very unfavorable outcome; therefore, you must not give up your hopes.

In the TAROT spread, the Card # 75 (= 'Valet' of Wands) appears in upside down posture. The present time-period is not favorable. If you are having travel plans, then it will be rather better to postpone them. Otherwise, you are likely to meet with many troubles on the way. Besides, you may face some difficulties with-, or in connection with-, a teenage child - probably a boy.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 11. Its distinctive characteristics are that it invariably signifies stiff opposition and conflict of serious sort. Since this card appeared in upside down (or negative) posture, its indications are not very favorable. You should remain very careful and cautious, and must consider all pros and cons before taking any major decision. You must also try your level best to avoid any possibility of conflict - if you don't wish to have complications of serious sort. If you are concerned about someone else, then a chance of receiving a startling bad news hangs on.

Card 2 - 62('Knight' of Pentacles) :

Meaning and Definition of the Card :

This Card corresponds to the 'Knight' of Pentacles. It is shown as a able-bodied young man of adventurous spirit sitting on a horseback; he is dressed as a merchant, and holding a glittering coin - which is balanced on it's edge and resting on his right palm. The knight is exhibiting the coin, but not seriously contemplating at it. The horse is at parade rest, and the knight is brave and demanding; he is a person having great capacities and potentials, and he is fully aware of it. But as he is not much experienced, he is impatient, and less willing to assume his responsibilities. If his expectations have not been fulfilled, then a quarrel is likely to erupt soon, and the knight is prepared to depart. Often this card means arrival or departure of a demanding person, with possibility of a quarrel, and breaking of a relationship. If this card appears in upside down posture, then it may signify a idle, careless, negligent, or irresponsible person - who might be discouraged, or removed from position, or he might leave on his own.

In the TAROT spread, the Card # 62 (= 'Knight' of Pentacles) appears in upside down posture. You are probably facing some problems owing to somebody else's lack of foresight; probably your own people are clinging to their status quo, and are quite reluctant to take unnecessary risk. Some time will be needed to change their attitude. For the time being, it will better for you not to force the issue.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 12. Its distinctive characteristics are that it invariably signifies sacrifice of some sort. Since this card appeared in upside down (or negative) posture, its indications are not at all favorable. You should and must remain very careful, cautious, and always on the alert. Card 3 - 38(Two of Cups) :

Meaning and Definition of the Card :

This Card corresponds to 2 of Cups. This signifies 'The Sacred Cord'. It is shown by two cups with rounded base are kept side by side, and in the middle a lily in full bloom is held in the hand; all are in upright positions. In the background, there is a painting in which a couple of swans are seen in close embrace; they are together dipping their bills in another lily in full bloom, gleefully they are enjoying sipping nectar. The meaning is obviously very clear. It indicates a peaceful and harmonious relationship between two persons. In case of love or marriage, a perfectly conjugate happy union is indicated. It may be a case of partnership/ collaboration also - in which case, it will bring in success, growth and prosperity. Either way, it signifies a cordial and lasting relationship.

In the TAROT spread, the Card # 38 (= 2 of Cups) appears in upside down posture. You should think twice before arriving at any agreement or forming any relationship or partnership with someone in immediate future. You must at first gather full information about the things involved, and consider all pros and cons - before putting your signature in any contract; it is not at all a favorable time for giving any commitment.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 2. This symbolizes imagination, harmony, union, fertility, and possibility of conception. Since this card appeared in upside down (or negative) posture, it indicates that there is something wrong in a recently introduced new factor, like a person, or a place, or a thing, or circumstances - from which you are less likely to derive any benefit in near future.

Card 4 - 45(Nine of Cups) :

The IVth Card: It indicates your house or home, property, comfort, peace of mind, satisfaction, etc.

Meaning and Definition of the Card :

This Card corresponds to 9 of Cups. This signifies 'The Rainbow Mirror'. It is shown as a set of nine cups is held in a frame, and a man's right hand held in the form of a fist with thumb raised is at the base of the frame; on the bottom of the frame, there is symbol of planet Jupiter in the left hand side, and symbol of zodiacal sign Pisces on the right hand side. Termed as 'Material Happiness', this card singularly emphasizes uninterrupted prosperity. It is a card of triumph, victory, harmony, growth, complete success, and total fulfillment. All of your plans will produce results, some of your cherished desires will be fulfilled, and a few of your ambitions will be realized. If some unfavorable cards appear in the same spread, then they can at the worst indicate some impediments causing retardation of the progress temporarily only - those will be sorted out pretty soon. All the people and things are in your favor, and dame fortune will surely bless you with plenty and abundance.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 9. It symbolizes finalization, completeness, inevitable outcome, etc; it also signifies originality, initiative, and drive - but at the same time it also indicates naivety and vulnerability. As this card appeared in upright (or positive) posture, the indications are very favorable for you. Your

circumstances might be like that even if a thing has already reached their concluding state, you can still have an opportunity to improve its condition by being active and expending your efforts.

Card 5 - 36('King' of Swords) :

The Vth Card: It indicates your lover, creativity, entertainment, pleasure, speculation, risks, etc.

Meaning and Definition of the Card :

This Card corresponds to the 'King' of Swords. It is often shown as a matured male person wearing a masculine crown and regal robes - sitting on a throne with an upright naked sword in his right hand as a symbol of his authority and power. His face is grim, and his left hand is resting on his left thigh in a closed fist manner indicating resolution. He stares like a brave lion in a ready-to-attack mood, and his gesture is to kill anyone who might cause his displeasure. He is not a symbol of justice, since he is concerned about furthering his own interests. This card indicates that you might be in a very dangerous position by getting into difficulties with a powerful authority. Immediately getting away from the place will be the best thing advisable for you.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 14. This number is indicative of fortune, but at the same time it also signifies challenges that bring in changes. It is shown as a well-dressed matured lady of honorable disposition is seated on a throne wearing a feminine crown - by holding a wand on her right hand, and a sunflower with a long stem on her left. The wand is taller than her, but she is not looking at it; she is looking forward with an intelligent, friendly, confiding gesture. She is in relaxed mood, conscious about her position, and at ease with herself. This card signifies a wealthy lady - who had acquired the financial standing herself. She is generous, loving, kind, sensible, and practical in case of relationships. If the enquirer is a male person, then this card may signify his wife or would-be wife; but if the enquirer is a female person, then it will mean a long-time friend and confidante. If this card indicates a situation, then it indicates a new venture - for which you will receive financial assistance and advice; by utilizing the qualities you possess, you will be successful in your efforts.

In the TAROT spread, the Card # 77 (= 'Queen' of Wands) appears in upside down posture. Be careful if some middle aged rich lady is offering you any encouragement or financial advice. For having too many irons in the fire, she might be concerned about her own interests. As she might be struggling to fulfill her own commitments, she might become desperate enough to make promises she might not be able to fulfill.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 13. This number is indicative of upheaval; but its intrinsic significations are that upheavals bring in some drastic changes, which are very desired. You should remain very careful, and watch your every step. You must not be over-optimistic, avoid taking risky chances, and totally refrain from misusing your power and influence. Card 7 - 39(Three of Cups) :

Also termed as the 'Dressing of the Sacred Spring', this card indicates auspiciousness, and ensures success in forming relationship; it brings in unhindered prosperity in business/ profession - leading to abundance and plenty, and utmost satisfaction. In case of love, it will lead to a happy union - concluding soon in a joyous celebration. There could be an addition to the family by birth or marriage. But if this card appears in upside down posture, then it indicates merely physical charm, gratification of sensual pleasures, small achievements, insignificant change/ transfer, and minor gains.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 3. This symbolizes assertion, expression, form, direction, etc and offers great scope for having rapid progress. As this card appeared in upright (or positive) posture, it indicates that circumstances will very soon turn in your favor. Even if the beginning did not appear to bear any promise - the new venture you have recently started or got involved in will proceed very well - from which you are sure to derive much of benefit in near future.

Card 8 - 35('Queen' of Swords) :

The VIIIth Card: It indicates joint ventures, money from bank or partner, physical intimacy, etc.

Meaning and Definition of the Card :

This Card corresponds to the 'Queen' of Swords. It is shown as a matured lady wearing a feminine crown and regal robes - sitting on a throne with an upright naked sword in her right hand as a symbol of her authority and power - which she uses for furthering her own interests. Her face is grim, and her left hand is raised in a gesture of delivering ruthless and cruel judgment. She is malicious, domineering, selfish, or spiteful. It is a symbol of possible personal loss of a dear relative, and helplessly falling in an emotionally devastating situation. This card indicates possibility of having intimate relationship with a middle-aged lady (or a young girl) whose family is very powerful, and it may lead to grave danger. So, look before you leap.

In the TAROT spread, the Card # 35 (= 'Queen' of Swords) appears in upside down posture. You should therefore remain very careful and cautious, and avoid any possibility to get entangled into direct confrontation with a tricky, malicious, spiteful, and dictatorial middle aged lady - who is extremely selfish, resentful, manipulative, or even cruel; she might be a nasty gossip-monger, or propaganda-specialist - who excels in hiding her faults, and blames others for anything gone wrong.

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 13. It indicates highly favorable results, and fruitful outcome; and it heralds the beginning of a new prosperous life. It will surely bring in a complete change, and certainly the conditions will be improved for the better by far. It is pictured as a divine figure of an winged angel, blowing on the victory trumpet, by leaning from a cloud - while below down the nude human figures of two or three persons - male and female both - being wonder-struck are looking above with the expression of awe clearly evident on their faces.

Symbolic Significations of the Card :

The Resurrection: Spiritual awakening, genius, aspiration, new regime, work, occupation, utility.

Allegorical Significations of the Card :

Denoted by 'The Resurrection'. It signifies that you are going to evolve and attain a higher spiritual plane. Your erstwhile consciousness and personal perceptions shall be dissolved to make way for deepest possible understanding. As you have crossed the final stage of knowledge, you are going to be resurrected to a completely new stage; you will realize that you are in a position to comprehend the incomprehensible. In the grand scheme of lifecycle, you are entering a new aeon; and it will happen to you naturally and beautifully. You must not be afraid of the change that is going to take place; as you have ascended by your own right, you are sure the get the rewards due.

In the shuffle, the Card #20 appears in inverted (or upside down) position - thereby indicating the possibility of a not-so-favorable outcome. You may have got into difficulties with some person or may have developed strong differences with some close relation. Some undesired developments might make you worried, and you may think that you may had taken a wrong decision, or adopted a stern stand on some issue; you may also consider about softening your stand - for offering your adversary a second chance. But it would rather be more advisable for you to safeguard your interests; even severance of ties is a better option than arriving at a compromise with such people - who wants to cheat or rob you.

Card 10 - 74(Ten of Wands) :

The Xth Card: It indicates goals, ambitions, reputation, credibility, honor, business/ profession, etc.

Meaning and Definition of the Card :

This Card corresponds to 10 of Wands. This signifies 'The Way of the Cross'. It is shown as ten thick wands are neatly arranged in a row with one end of each wand dug into the ground; at the background, a pagoda-like structure is seen, and the set of wands is serving as a fence for dispelling undesired intruders. This card is considered auspicious, but it has a double meaning; it will protect you like an angel as long as you deserve to be guarded. You should therefore have a very clear idea about the extent of your abilities, and must also know your limitations. If you are wise and prudent, then you are destined to extract large gains from even highly speculative stakes; but once you lose your level-headedness, and start being governed by greed and desire, then you may start declining downhill all on a sudden. This card can wipe off your all in a single go. If this card appears in upside down posture, then you should remain more careful and cautious; you may face difficulties owing to intrigues, and the possibility of facing a lawsuit might also hang on.

In the TAROT spread, the Card # 74 (= 10 of Wands) appears in upside down posture. Your current situation may appear to be insurmountable. You may start feeling very helpless; for not

knowing where to turn to, you may tend to give in and start believing that all you can do is to endure. You must reconsider your position, and change your views; why not look for some other alternatives? If you have the courage and confidence, you will soon be able to break the shackles and soar above.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 10. Its distinctive characteristics are that it invariably signifies extremities - very good or very bad, steep rise or precipitous fall, love or hate, arrogance or fear, etc. It does not offer any sort of middling or neutral result. Since this card appeared in upside down (or negative) posture, its indications are not very favorable. Card 11 - 47('Valet' of Cups) :

The cup contains something. He/ She appears to be waiting for someone for delivering the cup or its contents to him/ her. This card symbolizes auspiciousness. It indicates receiving a message, or arrival of a good-natured sensitive person of similar description (son/ daughter or brother/ sister) - who would gladly render some important service to you for your benefit. At times it indicates birth of a child or an idea, starting of a prospective enterprise with the help of someone.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 11. Its distinctive characteristics are that it invariably signifies stiff opposition and conflict of serious sort. As this card appeared in upright (or positive) posture, the indications are still quite favorable for you. Even if there is conflict, you can look forward to having it resolved by your own initiative. Card 12 - 40(Four of Cups) :

This Card corresponds to 4 of Cups. This signifies 'The Flood'. It is shown by four cups kept in four corners with a hand holding a long stemmed flower in full bloom in the center. In the left hand bottom corner, there is the symbol of Moon, and in the right hand bottom corner, there is the symbol of sign Cancer. It therefore has something to do with the mind, sentiment, home, comfort, etc. Termed as 'Blended Pleasure', this card is said to be a card of friendly counsel or mother's guidance; it is an indication of mild warning - which insists on for changing your negative outlook. Owing to your own dissatisfaction, you may refrain from recognizing or appreciating an advantage. In case of love or marriage, ask yourself if you like to become a lone old eagle? If your answer is not affirmative, then get rid of your discontent, and enjoy some sugar and honey of life.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds

to No. 4. This symbolizes basic understanding, careful planning, hard work, etc; it is quite queer that it also signifies sudden and unexpected developments. As this card appeared in upright (or positive) posture, it indicates that you will derive much of benefit owing to sudden change of circumstances. But you should remain alert and prepared. If you can understand the situation well, able to plan carefully, and willing to work hard, then you will very soon see the dawn of prosperity.

Overall Conclusion :

In this TAROT shuffle of 12 Cards' spread (Horoscope method), 9 or more Minor Arcana Cards have appeared. These cards cover the mundane affairs; so, it appears that you are concerned about the real life situations. As this class of cards indicative of relatively minor issues, it appears that you are not very much concerned about some matter of serious sort. The nature of outcome is less likely to have any strong effect on you.

In this TAROT shuffle of 12 Cards' spread (Horoscope method), 3 or more Minor Arcana 'Face' Cards have appeared. As this sub-class of cards indicates persons of some standing, it appears that you are very much concerned about dealing with some powerful and/ or influential persons. The nature of outcome is likely to have strong effect on you.

In this TAROT shuffle of 12 Cards' spread (Horoscope method), 4 or more Minor Arcana 'Cups' Cards have appeared. These cards cover the mundane affairs; so, it appears that you are concerned about the real life situations. As these cards have governance over the profound emotions, you are probably concerned about material possessions, belongings, cherished desires, creative talents, gifts, etc; although you might be feeling sad, your emotions may not be in consonance with the reality. As this class of cards indicative of relatively minor issues, it appears that you are not very much concerned about some matter of serious sort. The nature of outcome is less likely to have any strong effect on you.



Purpose of the Cards appearing in order

The 1st Card: This Card covers you. It indicates the circumstances you are presently in. The 2nd Card: This Card crosses you. It indicates the current influences operating on you. The 3rd Card: This Card crowns you. It reveals the possible influences to operate in future. The 4th Card: This Card is beneath you. It indicates the nature of possible future events. The 5th Card: This Card is behind you. It indicates the influences operating from the past. The 6th Card: This Card is before you. It indicates the nature of past events/ happenings. The 7th Card: This Card represents you. It indicates your feelings and reactions to situation. The 8th Card: This Card indicates your house. It indicates the outside influences. The 9th Card: This Card indicates your hopes, fears, desires, and expectations. The 10th Card: This Card indicates the final resolution, and probable outcome.

Card 1 - 42(Six of Cups) :

The 1st Card: This Card covers you. It indicates the circumstances you are presently in.

Meaning and Definition of the Card :

This Card corresponds to 6 of Cups. This signifies 'Faith'. It is shown as a set of six cups is held in a frame - which is hung on the wall. Termed as 'In Ector's Keeping', this is the card of sweet memories of the past and looking back in search of happiness. Your experiences due to the prevailing situations of the recent past might have had instilled a growing sense of discontent; it is reflected by this card, and it indicates that you can rediscover happiness. If you are looking back and remembering memories of happiness, then you are probably recalling your childhood days; ask yourself whether you can set the clock back? Don't brood over what you have lost, and try to understand that you can be happy once again. This card signifies the possible entry of someone into your life, or the occurring of some happy event will effect a radical change in your outlook, and you will be able to recognize the good things of life once again.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 6. It symbolizes quiet circumstances, smooth activities, adjustment, balance, etc; it also stands for harmony, love, and romance. As this card appeared in upright (or positive) posture, it indicates that circumstances will become highly favorable for you. Card 2 - 60(Ten of Pentacles) :

The 2nd Card: This Card crosses you. It indicates the current influences operating on you.

In the TAROT spread, the Card # 72 (= 8 of Wands) appears in upside down posture. Various obstacles and impediments are probably retarding your progress, and you might have become worried. Symbolic Significations of the Card :

The Sphinx: Wheel of fortune. Denotes cause and effect, and the moral law, periodicity, revolution and circulation.

Allegorical Significations of the Card :

Denoted by 'The Wheel of Fortune'. It signifies that you will view the things around you, and try to understand them in proper perspective. In this ephemeral world, where everything keeps changing and nothing lasts long, it is only very sensible to try to comprehend that both sadness and joy are the temporary turbulences of the volatile mind. 

It is pictured as a divine figure of an winged angel, blowing on the victory trumpet, by leaning from a cloud - while below down the nude human figures of two or three persons - male and female both - being wonder-struck are looking above with the expression of awe clearly evident on their faces.

Symbolic Significations of the Card :

The Resurrection: Spiritual awakening, genius, aspiration, new regime, work, occupation, utility.

Allegorical Significations of the Card :

The horse is at parade rest, and the knight is brave and demanding; he is a person having great capacities and potentials, and he is fully aware of it. But as he is not much experienced, he is impatient, and less willing to assume his responsibilities. If this card appears in upside down posture, then it may signify a idle, careless, negligent, or irresponsible person - who might be discouraged, or removed from position, or he might leave on his own.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 12. Its distinctive characteristics are that it invariably signifies sacrifice of some sort. As this card appeared in upright (or positive) posture, the indications are very favorable for you. If you can remember the saying that 'All that glitters are not gold', then definitely you will neither face any trouble of serious sort, nor be in for any gross disappointment.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

As this card appeared in upright (or positive) posture, it indicates that circumstances will become highly favorable for you. Card 10 - 63('Queen' of Pentacles) :

It represents hope in the form of inherited and acquired abilities, and also the awareness of possessing the abilities - with which all the obstacles and impediments can be overcome. However, if this card appears in the upside down posture, then it indicates a lady of suspicious nature; or a situation that is full of suspense, suspicion, and fear of evil.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 13. 

The Spiritual Ten Gates of Tarot method of 10 Cards' spread

Card 1 - 18(The Moon) :

The 1st Card: It indicates the significator for the issue.

Meaning and Definition of the Card :

This is Trumps Card # 18. It stands for the Moon (La Lune). It corresponds to the Hebrew letter 'Tzaddik'. It is pictured as a double-level card - with the Moon at the top center, shown in its crescent form within a full circle. The face of the Moon is shown within the circle looking downward. In some cases, the rays are seen emanating from the full circle - together with falling water-drops from the Moon, which symbolizes the descent of the life-spirit to the material world. You are endowed with a pure mind, and will attain a higher level of consciousness by looking inward - into your mind, and into your soul.

In this TAROT shuffle of 10 Cards' spread, 7 or more Minor Arcana Cards have appeared. These cards cover the mundane affairs; so, it appears that you are concerned about the real life situations. As this class of cards indicative of relatively minor issues, it appears that you are not very much concerned about some matter of serious sort. The nature of outcome is less likely to have any strong effect on you.

In this TAROT shuffle of 10 Cards' spread, 3 or more Minor Arcana 'Wands' Cards have appeared. 

The Heart's Desire Method of 8 Cards' spread

Card 1 - 61('Valet' of Pentacles) :

The 1st Card: It indicates what you are.

Meaning and Definition of the Card :

This Card corresponds to the 'Valet' of Pentacles. It is shown as a scholarly and reflective young boy (in some cases, a scholarly young girl) in a happy mood is standing in a field, holding a glittering coin in his/ her both hands or balancing it on the tips of his/ her fingers for showing it (to others); he/ she is well dressed, very pleased with himself/ herself, and admiring his/ her possession of the coin. It signifies a well-educated and intelligent person of refined nature and courteous behavior - probably having some artistic inclinations as well. But owing to tender age and lack of experience, the person might be more sensitive, less aware of reality, and somewhat impractical. Often this card brings in some good news or message; it indicates a period of enjoyment, pleasure, and satisfaction. However, if this card appears in upside down posture, then it indicates a banal person - who is interest-oriented, and of prodigal nature or dissipating habits; it may also bring in some disappointment or bad news.

In the TAROT spread, the Card # 61 (= 'Valet' of Pentacles) appears in upside down posture. You may have to deal with someone who thinks himself/ herself more important than he/ she actually is. This signifies 'Recognition'; it is also called 'The Horse Fair', and is shown as three small slim wands had been arranged in vertical position in parallel in a frame; the frame is hung on the wall, and on the floor a couple is busy for managing a horse - while an equine calf is partaking its food. This card is auspicious; it indicates that if you do not become impulsive, remain calm and quiet, and can act in an matured, dignified, intelligent, and tactful manner, then whatever the problems you are facing will be solved amicably. If the problems had been caused by non-cooperation or interference by some people, then you can look forward to active assistance or advice from some other people that will help you for arriving at a permanent solution. However, if this card appears in upside down posture, then it indicates that the pact will last for a short duration only - as the problems are likely to surface all over again at a not-too-distant date.

In the TAROT spread, the Card # 67 (= 3 of Wands) appears in upside down posture. The indications are not very favorable. People around you may seem to have started talking and behaving in a strange way and unpredictable manner. The goings-on around you may tell upon your nerves, and you may appear to lose your self-confidence. The period is not good for starting a new venture or getting into a new deal; you should rather concentrate on your routine affairs only.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 3. You had probably been reeling under sadness or gloom; on the bright side, this temporary phase will be over pretty soon. Your circumstances and mental condition is going to improve at a fast space; you will be start feeling happy once again.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcanas' of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 5. It symbolizes excitement, movement, adventure, advancement, victory, etc. Since this card appeared in upside down (or negative) posture, its indications are not favorable. You are likely to face some political upheaval, or social disorder, or calamitous cause. Even if you had planned carefully, and worked very hard, yet you may not obtain the expected results. You should therefore stow away adequate provisions for covering the approaching 'rainy' days.

Card 4 - 37(Ace of Cups) :

The 4th Card: It indicates your past.

Meaning and Definition of the Card :

This Card corresponds to Ace (= 1) of Cups. This signifies 'The Open Channel'. It is shown as a large cup of round base held upright is resting on the palm, which has come out of the cloud. At the bottom the sea is seen, while water is seen to steadily flowing out in the form of arching fountains. Thus, the cup represents divine grace - since it is a never-ending source of its contents, which are being freely given away. It indicates celebration, merry-making, union, fertility, and fruitful consummation. It represents the onset of a true, devoted, and lasting relationship. If the query has nothing to do with love or marriage, then it will indicate forming of lasting partnership/ collaboration with a friend. It promises a favorable outcome, and ensures full satisfaction.

In the TAROT spread, the Card # 37 (= 'Ace' of Cups) appears in upside down posture. You may have lost faith in someone you have trusted long since; probably you are facing some problem with a relationship or a friendship - which may appear to be heading for a split. Alternately, you

might be concerned about virility, fertility, childbirth, etc. If some other cards of the spread also offer unfavorable indications, then you should keep your fingers crossed.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained an 'Ace' card of the Minor 'Arcanas' of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 1. This symbolizes creativity, beginning, and original action. Since this card appeared in upside down (or negative) posture, it indicates that there is something in its initial stage, which requires your immediate attention and re-consideration; otherwise, it is likely to bring in an unfavorable outcome for you in the long run.

Card 5 - 60(Ten of Pentacles) :

The 5th Card: It indicates your partner's past.

If this card appears in upright posture, then it lays special emphasis on family matters and/ or business establishment; it also indicates possibility of receiving a gift or legacy. However, if this card appears in upside down posture, then it indicates uncertainty, loss in speculation, theft or robbery, etc. The person should not take chances, and remain on the alert for safeguarding his/ her possessions and interests.

In the TAROT spread, the Card # 60 (= 10 of Pentacles) appears in upside down posture. It appears that you may not be very progressive minded person; if you are trying to bog down someone for conforming to tradition, and refuse to allow him/ her to change with the times, then you might be in for meeting with stiff resistance - which might even lead to quarrels in the family, and even division of property.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 10. 





Purpose of the Cards appearing in order

Purpose of the Cards appearing in order

The 1st Card: It denotes 'Significator for the Issue'. The 2nd Card: It denotes 'Actions taken or to be taken'. The 3rd Card: It denotes 'Resolution/ Final Outcome'.

Card 1 - 42(Six of Cups) :

The 1st Card: It denotes 'Significator for the Issue'.

Card 2 - 56(Six of Pentacles) :

The 2nd Card: It denotes 'Actions taken or to be taken'.

It is shown as a prosperous person in a happy mood is giving away corns to an elderly couple - appearing to be very poor and in great want. Card 3 - 61('Valet' of Pentacles) :

In the TAROT spread, the Card # 61 (= 'Valet' of Pentacles) appears in upside down posture. You may have to deal with someone who thinks himself/ herself more important than he/ she actually is. He/ She might be reluctant to take unnecessary risks, and thereby might cause blocking of your prospect of advancement. You can change the situation to your favor if you can appeal to his/ her heart by using your head in a subtle manner; this is since the motive of the person is not at all suspect.

Numerological Interpretations of the Card :

While shuffling, you have obtained a card of the Minor 'Arcana' Cards of Tarot, which corresponds to No. 11. The nature of outcome is less likely to have any strong effect on you.

In this TAROT shuffle of 3 Cards' spread, 1 or more Minor Arcana 'Face' Cards have appeared. As this sub-class of cards indicates persons of some standing, it appears that you are very much concerned about dealing with some powerful and/ or influential persons. The nature of outcome is likely to have strong effect on you.

In this TAROT shuffle of 3 Cards' spread, none of the Minor Arcana 'Swords' Cards has appeared. As this class of cards signifies mental condition and intellectual pursuits, the absence of these cards indicate that you are not concerned with such things; it appears that you are concerned about some other things.

In this TAROT shuffle of 3 Cards' spread, 1 or more Minor Arcana 'Cups' Cards have appeared. These cards cover the mundane affairs; so, it appears that you are concerned about the real life situations. As these cards have governance over the profound emotions, you are probably concerned about material possessions, belongings, cherished desires, creative talents, gifts, etc; although you might be feeling sad, your emotions may not be in consonance with the reality. As this class of cards indicative of relatively minor issues, it appears that you are not very much concerned about some matter of serious sort. The nature of outcome is less likely to have any strong effect on you.

In this TAROT shuffle of 3 Cards' spread, 1 or more Minor Arcana 'Pentacles' Cards have appeared. These cards cover the mundane affairs; so, it appears that you are concerned about the real life situations. As these cards have governance over everything connected with the material world, you are probably concerned about business deal, employment, earnings, moneymatters, investments, belongings, property, etc. Probably you wish to have something immediately; but you should be practical and have patience. As this class of cards indicative of relatively minor issues, it appears that you are not very much concerned about some matter of serious sort. The nature of outcome is less likely to have any strong effect on you.

In this TAROT shuffle of 3 Cards' spread, none of the Minor Arcana 'Wands' Cards has appeared. As this class of cards signifies level of attainment in professional career, the absence of this class of cards indicates that you are not concerned about anything such; it appears that you are concerned about some other things.

In this TAROT shuffle of 3 Cards' spread, 1 or more Cards have appeared in 'upside down' (or negative) posture. Although this posture by itself does not mean negation or denial, it nevertheless indicates the circumstances are not much in favor; there could be many obstacles and impediments to contend with, or you may meet with resistance or opposition. So, you should remain very careful and cautious, and shedding all your over-optimism, you must expend your efforts in a directed manner. You should also be fair, and modest in your expectations.
